WHAT IS REBUILDING THE CIRCLE?

Rebuilding the Circle (RTC) is a strengths-based continuum of comprehensive treatment services to heal the impacts of sexual harm in Nuu-chah-nulth families and communities. RTC is Quu?as based, trauma-informed and holistic. We are on a journey of healing for all and restoring the strength of Nuu-chah-nulth communities.

We believe healing is possible for all, with very few exceptions. The Men's Restoration Program creates a circle of support and reduces risk for those who have harmed sexually, while implementing the RTC Treatment Model based off of the expertise of Jane Middleton-Moz, Dr. Liam E. Marshall, and the RTC Core Team.

OPEN POSITIONS:

CLINICAL FACILITATOR

MSW OR EQUIVALENT(CONTRACTED)

- Facilitate Intake Interviews with potential clients, developing safety plans as needed
- Collaborate with co-facilitators and cultural support workers. Deliver daily group programming materials
- Individual counselling when required

CLINICAL COUNSELLOR

MSW OR EQUIVALENT (CONTRACTED)

- Work closely with the Clinical Team to provide continuous, wrap-around care for RTC programs
- Act as a Clinical Support to the Clinical Team and the clients when in session
- Provide After-Care to the clients when session has ended including individual counselling and check-ins

SUPPORT WORKER

DIPLOMA, BSW, MSW (IN-PROGRESS) OR EQUIVALENT (CONTRACTED)

- Direct client support in applying psycho-education tools including social skills, life skills, resiliency, coping
- Identify crisis and prevent or de-escalate
- Complete case notes, reports, and daily log entries
